Children not attending Catholic schools do a two-year catechetical programme for First Communion and Confirmation. See parish website. Not every parish can provide this service but for those children from our parish in Navan schools the following applies: Navan Parish Catechetical Programme prepares children in schools which are not under the patronage of the Bishop of Meath for the Sacraments. Children in Second Class or above can join a 2-year programme to prepare for the Sacraments of First Penance & First Holy Communion. A meeting takes place on Tuesday 10th October at 6:15pm in St Oliver's church with parents and guardians who have enrolled in the 2023-2024 Programme. Enrolment forms can be collected from Navan Parish Office and returned not later than Sunday 1st October.

Children in Fourth class or above may apply for a 2-year programme for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Those wishing to join Year I must apply for admission. Children from previous years who have completed Year I must also apply for admission to Year II.

Parish Schools: under the current denominational school system Catholic Schools come under the patronage of the local bishop and are governed by a Board of Management in accordance with the Directives of the Dept of Education & Science, with the support of the Catholic Primary School Management Association. The term of the current Boards ends on 1st November and new Boards must be formed to take up office on 1st December for a four-year term. The BOM is composed of the Patron's two nominees (usually the PP and one other member approved by the Patron); the Principal and one other elected teacher; two elected Parents, one Mother and one Father. This 'core Board' then appoints a further two community representatives to the BOM. This lengthy process commences now.
