Diocesan news: as reported in last week's bulletin, there has been a meeting of the **Council of Priests**, made up of priest-delegates from each Deanery, and a meeting of **Navan Deanery**. Both meetings centred on the current state and needs of the diocese with fewer priests, smaller congregations and fewer active parishioners, yet with 69 parishes, 150 churches and many other ministries and activities to support. Clearly, significant change is required across all areas of parish life. No parish is an island and all must now work together to develop a plan for the next 5-10 years.

No change can be undertaken or even discussions held without the input and participation of the lay faithful, who may indeed be more adaptable, inventive and creative than the clergy imagine!

An Assembly of the clergy takes place for two days in November and thereafter the process of consultation and collaboration at parish level will begin in collaboration with the bishop, priests and the newly formed **Pastoral Assemblies** in every parish.
