All Souls' Day Indulgence: The Catechism of the Catholic Church in paragraph 1030 teaches: 'All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven'.

For those who are in purgatory, there is a great need of the prayers of those in heaven and those still on earth to help the souls complete their total conversion to Christ. The Holy Souls are those who have left this world and whose eternal life with God is assured, but there is, as it were, a 'deficit' of goodness or forgiveness, or some other failing or shortcoming in life yet to be made up before the soul can see God in His glory. Just as we in this life help each other to live good lives and reach the Kingdom, this support continues after death. An Indulgence then is an act of spiritual solidarity with the departed in order to be part of their final journey towards God.

To 'gain' this indulgence for a soul the Church asks that:1) From noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father & Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting an Our Father and the Apostles Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time.

November Altar List of the Dead: Envelopes available so individuals, families, households or groups of friends can get together to recall and record the names of all whom they have known and loved in life and whose memory they keep alive by the various rituals we have in November, a month dedicated to remembrance and prayer for the faithful departed, the Holy Souls.

Annual Choral Candlelit Service of Remembrance and Prayer for the Dead and Bereaved on Friday 24th November at 7.30pm, with the combined parish choirs. Invitations will be sent to those bereaved since November 2022, but all are welcome to come and join in prayer and offer a candle in loving memory at what is always a moving and impressive occasion in parish life.
