November Rituals: On Friday night the annual parish Service of Remembrance and Prayer for the Dead and Comfort for the Bereaved took place in Johnstown church. Attended by the biggest crowd in many years, it was a poignant commemoration marking the grief and the hope of all whom the parish has served at their time of loss this past year. The combined choir was superb and many people in attendance spoke of how uplifted they were by the singing and by the support and compassion of the parish.
