Parish Pastoral Assembly will meet this Monday. The members have been asked to each draw up a short Parish Mission Statement. At the meeting, these will be compiled into one or more versions to be put to the parish for comment and input before a final agreed Mission Statement is decided upon that best describes our parish and aims. There will also be the election of a PPA Chairperson and Secretary, a Commissioning/Blessing of the members and submitting our Constitution to the bishop.

Feasts and Fasts: St Brigid's Day falls this Thursday 1st Feb, with a Public Holiday on Monday 5th. Crosses in honour of St Brigid will be blessed at 9.30am Mass. The **Feast of the Presentation in the Temple**, also called **Candlemas**, occurs on Friday 2nd February. Anyone who wishes to have candles blessed for use in the home can bring them to the morning Mass or leave them in advance in the sacristy, with their name attached. St Blaise, with the ever-popular Blessing of Throats on Saturday 3rd February, so throats will be blessed at the Vigil Masses on Saturday. Ash Wednesday, 14th February, also St Valentine's Day so will be observed in a more restrained way by the faithful! **St Patrick's Day** is Sunday 17th March, Masses at the usual times, and Monday a Public Holiday.

Gaelic Prayers to St Brigid

'From all sin and all harm, from all danger and woe, Guard me, Mary of Ireland, wherever I go, O Brigid, be with me until the road's end, O Help me to pass through that Gate as God's Friend'. 'May God's blessing be upon us from All Saint's Day to St Brigid's Day; from St Brigid's Day to May Day; from May Day to August and from August to All Saints' Day."

Evening Prayer at the Cathedral, Mullingar, this Sunday at 4pm with the members of all the Religious Orders, active and retired, in our diocese. The whole diocese is invited to join in this celebration of the immense contribution made by Religious Sisters, Brothers & Priests, in the past and still today, in Catholic Education, Healthcare and all manner of spiritual, social and pastoral care and outreach. It will also mark the Fortieth Anniversary of Bishop Michael Smith's Episcopal Ordination in 1983.

Sacramental Preparation: the weeks ahead will see a great deal of activity marking the different stages of preparation for sacraments for the children of the parish. Weeks have already been spent in the immense task of distributing through the schools and online the forms requesting First Confession, First Communion and Confirmation. Getting the forms completed and returned is a slow process! **Confirmation**: last weekend we had the uplifting sight of the young people for Confirmation coming to enrol at Mass. Of the 124 candidates, 82 in St Stephen's & 42 in Lismullen, 114 joined us for one of those Masses and made their public request for the sacrament. **First Confession and Communion**: 69 boys and girls in St Stephen's and 25 in Lismullen are preparing for these sacraments and will have an Enrolment Ceremony for St Stephen's on Tuesday 27th February and Lismullen on Wednesday 28th Feb in Johnstown church. First Confession will be on Tuesday 12th March at 7pm for Lismullen and Monday 15th April for St Stephen's.

For **Children over the age of seven** who have enrolled for a sacrament in the parish but are not yet baptised, after consultation with their parents, there will be one great christening celebration this Sunday in Johnstown church after 11am Mass.
