The Pastoral Assembly met last Monday: it is hoped on an upcoming Saturday afternoon to have a *Parish Lenten Day of Prayer and Action* focusing on the three aspects of Lent: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving, with an emphasis on some aspect of practical care for the poor and needy. Suggestions welcome as to content and format of this event.

The PPA, having reflected on a number of versions, proposes the following as our parish and PPA Mission Statement:

'We the faithful of Johnstown and Walterstown parish, as a vibrant Catholic community, seek to welcome and unite all generations and cultures in faith through prayer by providing opportunities for parishioners to grow in their relationship with God.'

Suggested weekly exercises for Lent – If able to do so, go without ONE meal some day this week in solidarity with the hungry poor of the world OR commit yourself to NEVER exceeding the speed limit this week as an exercise in self-control and love of neighbour OR offer forgiveness to someone who has offended you or seek the forgiveness of someone you have hurt, offended or spoke ill of.
