**Statement of Irish Episcopal Conference on the Referendums on 8<sup>th</sup> March**: 'On arrival in Ireland for the World Meeting of Families in 2018, Pope Francis met at Dublin Castle with representatives of civil, cultural & religious life, including the Taoiseach and members of Government. He said he was visiting Ireland to help families "*reaffirm their commitment to loving fidelity, mutual assistance and reverence for God's gift of life in all its forms, but also to testify to the unique role played by the family in the education of its members, and the development of sound and flourishing social fabric"*. He added, "*Families are the glue of society, their welfare cannot be taken for granted, but must be promoted and protected by every appropriate means"*.
