A Plenary Gathering of clergy and members of the Pastoral Assemblies of the eight parishes of Navan Deanery was held last week to begin consultation on the grouping of parishes and clergy to meet changing needs. The meeting was very well attended, and our PPA well represented. Discussion took place on three main issues: 1) *Clustering* or re-configuring of neighbouring parishes in groups of three or more to better serve the people within that newly-formed area, while retaining the identity of existing parishes and their PPA and Finance Committees; 2) *Training* of people in parishes to take on faith formation and leadership roles; 3) the *Care of Priests* in the sense of understanding and supporting their ministry in very changed circumstances and helping them to focus more on sacramental and pastoral life instead of admin etc, also that each priest be part of a team that will collaborate more effectively.

The **bridges** across the Boyne and Blackwater rivers that link our eight parishes emerged as symbols of our desire to strengthen the bonds of communion between our parishes.

Our PPA meets this Monday to further discuss these matters as well as some input into our parish celebration of Holy Week & Easter.

Statement of the Irish Bishops appealing for peace in Gaza This week, our bishops emphatically called for a ceasefire in Gaza, stating: "Let us all say: enough ... Stop the War! In saying this, we join with many in our parishes, together with all people of goodwill, in demanding an immediate end to the daily horror of killing, wounding and destruction of property and infrastructure there."
