Johnstown church: a team, including a suspended ceiling contractor, will carry out work on the tiled ceiling on Wednesday and, having inspected the roof space, will issue a report and recommendations as to how we proceed. The PP will propose to the Finance Committee that a 'ceiling group' be formed to come up with proposals for the eventual replacement of the current suspended section of the ceiling with something more in keeping with the style of the church, ideally a timber or simulated timber structure.
