

● Confirmation Sponsors: Our young Confirmation Candidates, who will celebrate this important sacrament on the 3rd April in St Mary's Church, Navan, welcome their chosen sponsors to Masses this weekend as they ask God's blessing upon their chosen sponsors who have agreed to take on this essential role in the lives of our candidates. The chosen sponsors are the people the candidates have chosen to stand beside them as they receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, and who will be with them in the years ahead to help grow in the Christian Faith.

At a minimum, a sponsor must fulfill the requirements of being a practicing Catholic, over 16 years of age, who has received Confirmation themselves and live a life of faith that befits the role undertaken.

However, it is a role that has taken on greater importance in the challenges that young people face today, and so must be undertaken with the sense that the Christian Sponsor of Confirmation are there to encourage and assist the candidate in their Christian faith, particularly in the practice of that faith; to be able to guide them in the understanding of the Christian Faith by sharing from their own knowledge and experience; to pray daily for the candidate, to guide and encourage them in the living out of a moral and virtuous life, and finally helping them to recognise and develop their God-given talents for the benefit of others, and to discover their vocation in life. It is a demanding responsibility, just as it is a privilege and

an honour to be asked to be a sponsor. May God who calls our sponsors for this task, assist

them with His grace to carry it out to the best of their abilities.
