Mourners coming for funerals have had difficulty finding spaces because others have left their cars while heading off to work all day,

or attending classes, and guests at weddings (already running late (a)) have had to circle around because of the lack of spaces available. HGV's, lorries and Farm vehicles have also exhibited dangerous driving in the carpark, which should be a pedestrian friendly area and so are prohibited from driving and parking in the carpark. Unfortunately there has also been a rise of anti-social behaviours late at night and so carparking is prohibited after 8pm. We hope these regulations will allow the carpark to be utilised fully for the good of the parish.
