● **400th Anniversary Celebrations of St Oliver Plunkett** continue this Sunday with the procession with the Relics of St Oliver to the Church of St Peter, Drogheda, beginning from Holy Family Church, Drogheda at 3pm. All most welcome to come and honour our own native born saint, and the last Catholic Martyr to die at Tyburn, England. Saint Oliver was born on 1st November 1625 in Lough Crew, Co. Meath, and then 50 years ago he was canonised by Pope Paul VI. Holy Mass will be offered at 4pm in St Peter's. Celebrant and Preacher: Archbishop Eamon Martin, DD, 23rd Successor to St Oliver in the See of Armagh. Visiting bishops and other dignitaries will also be in attendance.
