

#### SAINTS THIS WEEK

• Memorial of St Vincent DePaul: 27th Sept: "A Heart for the Poor" Born in 1581 in France, St. Vincent

de Paul devoted his life to serving Christ through the poor, the sick, and the forgotten. Ordained a priest at just 19, he quickly became known not only for his preaching but for his deep compassion and tireless work among those in need. He founded the Congregation of the Mission to bring the Gospel to rural communities and reform the clergy. Alongside St. Louise de Marillac, he co-founded the Daughters of Charity, a ground breaking community of women who served the poor outside the cloister—an revolutionary for its time. St. Vincent's legacy lives on in the Society of St. Vincent de shed in 1833 and active in parishes around the world, including our own. His life reminds

Paul, established in 1833 and active in parishes around the world, including our own. His life reminds us that holiness is found not only in prayer, but in action—especially when that action lifts up the least among us. Canonized in 1737, he is the patron saint of charitable works, and a model of Christian love in motion. His body is kept in the Church of "Charity is the cement which binds communities to God and persons to one another." — St. Vincent de Paul

Memorial of St Pio of Pietrelcina (Padre Pio): 23<sup>rd</sup> Sept. Born in the small village of Pietrelcina and joined the Capuchin Order when he was 16. After being ordained, he lived for the next of San Giovanni Rotondo where he was sought after as a spiritual advisor, confessor and intercessor. He a died a few days after the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his receiving the 'Stigmata' the wounds of the Crucified Christ and over 100,00 people attended his funeral "Joy, with
