• Feasts of the Holy Angels. This week we will celebrate two feasts dedciated to the angels. The Archangels - St Michael, St Gabriel and St Raphael - will be celebrated on Monday, traditionally known as Michaelmas. St Michael is mentioned in the Book of Revelation as the leader of the heavenly hosts. He is patron saint of Police Forces, Soldiers and those who stand up for truth and justice.
